COMPLETION OF PHASE 1 OF INNOVATION CAMPUS CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Grand Farm announced it fully achieved Phase 1 of its Innovation Campus capital campaign with contributions from over 40 families and organizations totalling \$15.1M.

Phase 1 included 140 acres of land used for collaboration, research, and demonstrations, and a 25,000 sq. foot facility to host groups, demonstrate technology, and upskill the region.

The campaign was launched in February of 2022 when Grand Farm was awarded a \$10 Million matching grant by the North Dakota Legislature and North Dakota Department of

INNOVATION SHOP CONSTRUCTION

Grand Farm's Innovation Shop will be the first building to go up on the Innovation Campus. Infrastructure construction started over the summer on the site, and structural work began in the fall including foundation and steel work. Work on the Innovation Shop is scheduled to be completed by Summer 2024.

Grand Farm welcomed an average of 100 weekly visitors to our Innovation Campus, hosting 23 field plot tours, and three Field Days events during the growing season. Attendees included industry professionals, representatives from various states and countries, educators, government officials, and growers, demonstrating broad interest in agricultural practices, technology, sustainability, and collaboration opportunities.

STRATEGIC EXPANSION + AGCO ANCHOR TENANT ANNOUNCEMENT

Our field footprint expanded from 140 to 590 acres with the acquisition of the full contiguous section at our Innovation Campus. In September, Grand Farm announced AGCO as an anchor tenant of the Innovation Campus utilizing 300 acres to build the Dakota Smart Farm. AGCO aims to develop innovative farming practices to create a truly sustainable farm, specifically focusing on precision agriculture technologies and high-value retrofit solutions.

Participants included education stakeholders, such as teachers, students, faculty and state leaders.

Grand Farm hosted a series of engaging workshops and events in 2023, free of cost thanks to our event sponsors. In June, the **EduConnect Workshop** at the Cultivate Conference connected educators with AgTech professionals, fostering knowledge exchange for their students. August saw the **TechConnect Workshop** at the Autonomous Nation Conference, linking students and educators with industry experts to explore career opportunities in technology and autonomous fields. The **Livestock Bonanza!** in September engaged over 100 students in agriculture-themed challenges, trivia, culinary delights, and hands-on interactions with llamas, goats, ponies, and calves, creating a memorable learning experience.

In 2023, Grand Farm continued to strengthen its ties with growers through dedicated initiatives and engagement platforms. This year's focus on connection and dialogue has not only enriched relationships but also paved the way for exciting opportunities in the coming year.

GROWER PAIN POINT REPORT

Grand Farm's Grower Pain Point Report serves as a vital link between growers and the global AgTech ecosystem. Addressing challenges faced by farmers and ranchers, this report initiates feedback loops with stakeholders such as startups, corporations, educators,



researchers, investors, and government agencies. By spotlighting grower challenges, Grand Farm catalyzes innovation, fostering solutions that enhance productivity, profitability, and overall resilience in agriculture.

OUR GROWER ADVISORY BOARD

The Grand Farm Grower Advisory Board is a group of innovative growers that provide advice, feedback, and recommendations to the Grand Farm team on a range of agricultural technologies and environmental issues that are of importance to agriculture and rural communities. Their insights have been instrumental in shaping Grand Farm's events, engagements, and overall support for the AgTech ecosystem. Our commitment to collaboration ensures that the agricultural community's voice remains at the forefront of Grand Farm's initiatives.

Being on the Grand Farm Grower Advisory Board has been a very educational and interesting journey for me. We were chosen to add our input to the system as farmers saying what farmers need and would be interested in trying. Little did I know how many new inventions are coming at us, and if they seem like there is no purpose on our farm, we are free to express our opinions on that. The knowledge I have gained and the insight into the process has me excited about the future of agriculture. Technology will continue to expand our possibilities and will change how we farm in the



2023 PROJECTS

Grand Farm's Program Management Office (PMO) coordinates our ecosystem, Innovation Campus, and innovation framework to solve problems with partners. We work directly with innovation teams to help them apply innovative thinking within their organizations and provide direct capabilities and services to ease technology research, development, and validation.

2023 was year one working on our Innovation Campus where we utilized 100 acres to conduct projects across seven partners.







GROWING OUR REACH

Grand Farm continued to expand strategic project relationships in state and outside of our region with partners including the United States Department of Agriculture's Agricultural Research Service.

EVOLVING PROJECT COMPLEXITY

Grand Farm's field projects have grown in complexity, aligning with team expansion and capability-building. In 2023, we provided monthly drone imagery and limited analytics. In 2024, we plan to enhance this by increasing drone imagery frequency and analytics depth, enriching field trial data. We also collected on-field agronomic data for partners' research, with plans for further growth in this capability.

FACILITATING INNOVATION

One of the key challenges found in our Grower Pain Point Report was the proliferation of herbicide resistant weeds. Through multiple opportunities, the Grand Farm Innovation-as-a Service team has engaged with the key challenge of herbicide-resistant weeds. This has been accomplished through researching technologies, engaging with startups, and collaborating on projects across our platform.
